All matriculated students may apply for an exhibition to show work in any medium

DEADLINE: 5PM, SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2012

Each proposal must be clearly labeled and should contain the information requested below. Please include all contact information so that we may reach you during the summer months.

ARTIST STATEMENT – No more than one page in length describing your work, medium, working methods and ideas, as well as how you intend to exhibit it.

EXAMPLES OF YOUR WORK – Submit no more than five examples of artwork. Work submitted should be indicative of what you will be exhibiting. Send both high and low resolution formats of your images:

DIGITAL IMAGES

High resolution images: TIFF format at 300 dpi, largest dimension at 14 inches. Low resolution images: JPEG format at 72 dpi, largest dimension at 10 inches.

VIDEO/DVD

Please note that there is a three minute limit. Cue your video to the segment you wish the jury to review. Label the disk with your name, date, title, etc. Digital media in MPEG format only.

PROPOSALS OF WORK IN PROGRESS

Explain in detail your idea for the work and exhibition requirements. Include low resolution digital images of: drawings, models, other visual representations of works in progress.

LIST OF IMAGES – All image files should be properly named and be accompanied by a corresponding list containing title, year of completion, dimensions (height x width x depth), medium and file name of each JPEG or MPEG.

Submit this completed proposal form, materials listed above (include eight printed copies of both artist statement and list of images), and a large self-addressed stamped envelope to:

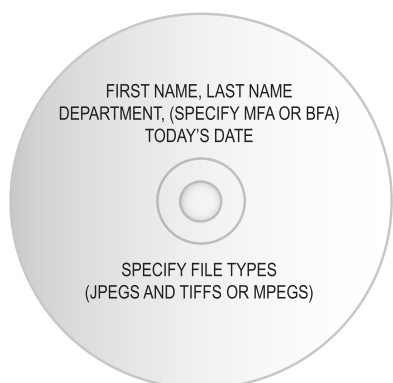


SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE

Department chairs recommend students for the jury that evaluates the proposals. The jury reviews the proposals, evaluates the work based on quality and consistency, and votes either to accept, reject or place the proposal(s) on a waiting list.

The assistant director oversees the jury and curates the exhibitions by theme, based on the proposals accepted by the jury. The assistant director will notify you of the jury's decision the first week of April, 2012. Please call 212.592.2145 if you have questions about the call for entries selection and notification procedure.
